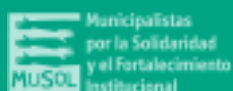
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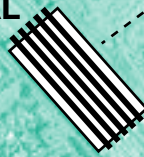

## FROM THE AIRPORT TO THE CITY

Pescara Airport (Aeroporto d'Abruzzo – PSR) is located just 10 minutes from the city center.

You can take Bus Line 8 (TUA Abruzzo) directly to the central station (Pescara Centrale).

Tickets can be purchased on board or via the **myCicero app**.



## BUS IN TOWN

Pescara's public transportation is operated by TUA Abruzzo. Tickets are available at newsstands, ticket machines, or through the **myCicero** or **Moovit apps**.



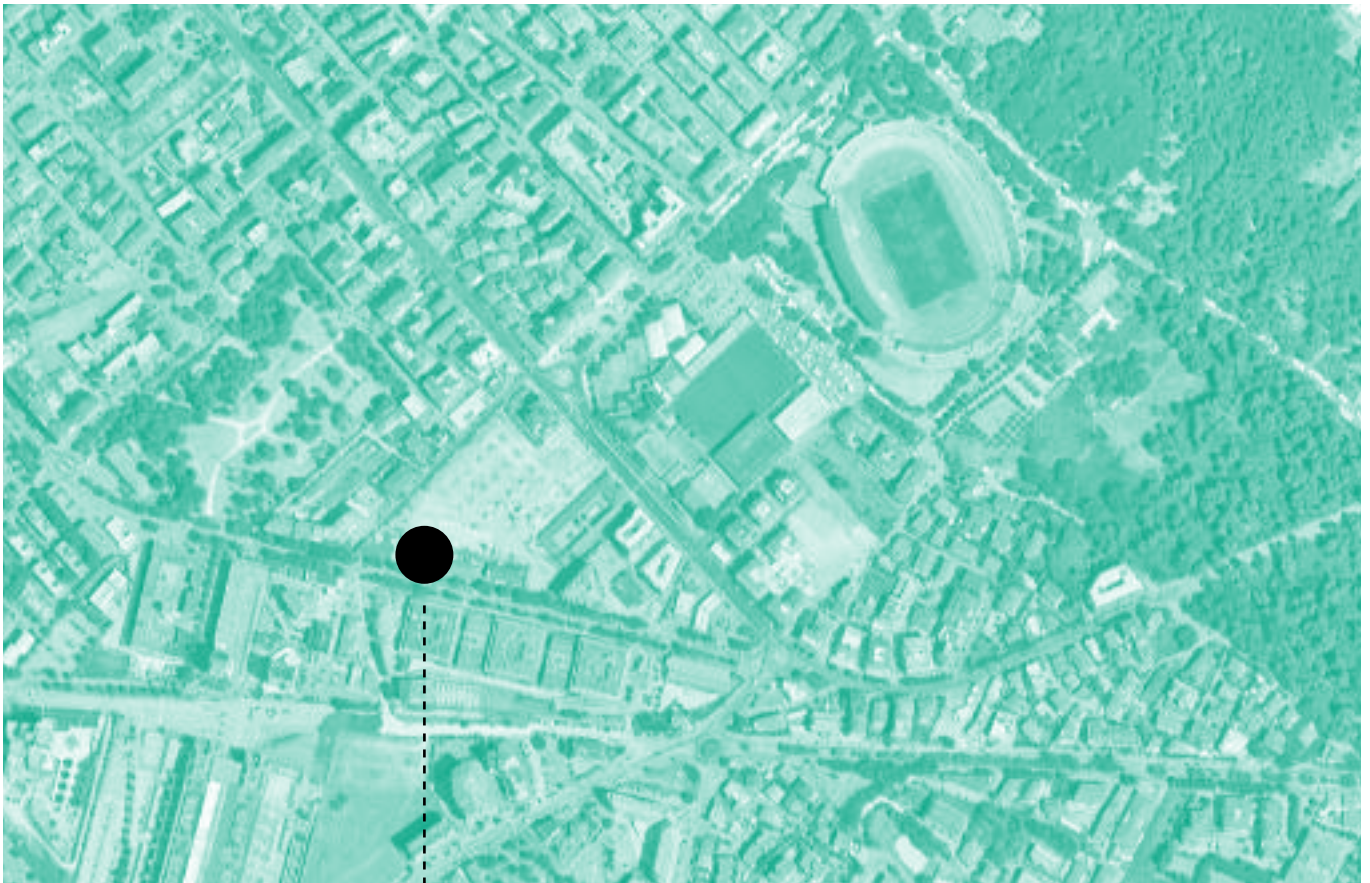

# SUGGESTED ACCOMMODATION

## REGENT HOTEL – 3 ★

LUNGOMARE CRISTOFORO COLOMBO, 64 – PESCARA

**BY CAR:** approx. 1.5 km (5 minutes)

**ON FOOT:** approx. 1.2 km (15 minutes)

Located on Pescara's southern seafront, Hotel Regent offers comfortable rooms with private balconies, some with sea views.

## HOTEL ESPLANADE – 4 ★

PIAZZA I MAGGIO, 46 – PESCARA

**BY CAR:** approx. 2.5 km (7–10 minutes)

**ON FOOT:** approx. 2.2 km (25–30 minutes)

Located in the heart of Pescara, right on the seafront, Hotel Esplanade offers air-conditioned rooms, free Wi-Fi, and a rooftop restaurant with panoramic views.

## G HOTEL PESCARA – 4 ★

VIA STAZIONE FERROVIARIA, 100 – PESCARA

**BY CAR:** approx. 2.8 km (8–10 minutes)

**ON FOOT:** approx. 2.5 km (30 minutes)

A modern hotel just 50 meters from Pescara Central Station and 900 meters from the beach. It features spacious rooms, free Wi-Fi, and a rich breakfast buffet.

## AMBRA PALACE HOTEL – 3 ★

VIA QUARTO DEI MILLE, 28 – PESCARA

**BY CAR:** approx. 2.5 km (7–10 minutes)

**ON FOOT:** approx. 2.2 km (25–30 minutes)

Located in the heart of Pescara, Ambra Palace Hotel is just 300 meters from the central train station and 500 meters from the beach.

# MUSEUMS TO VISIT

## **Museo delle Genti d'Abruzzo**

Located in the historic center, this ethnographic museum tells the story and traditions of the Abruzzo region through 13 exhibition rooms.



## **Imago Museum**

Opened in 2021, this contemporary art museum features Scandinavian impressionists and 20th-century Italian artists.



## **Museo Paparella Treccia Devlet**

Housed in the elegant Villa Urania, it showcases a fine collection of Castelli ceramics and 19th-century Italian paintings.



## **Basilio Cascella Civic Museum**

Dedicated to artist Basilio Cascella, this museum exhibits graphic works, paintings, and ceramics in the very building where he once lived and worked.



## **Museum of the 19th Century – Di Persio-Pallotta Foundation**

A private collection of 19th-century artworks offering a window into Italy's artistic heritage of the time.



## **CLAP Museum – Comics Lab Art Pescara**

the CLAP Museum is a four-story cultural space entirely dedicated to comic art. It houses one of Italy's largest collections of works by Andrea Pazienza, a seminal figure in Italian comics, who spent part of his youth in Pescara.



# OUTDOOR SPACES & WALKS

## **Ponte del Mare**

This iconic pedestrian and cycling bridge offers panoramic views of the Adriatic and the city—perfect for photos and strolls.



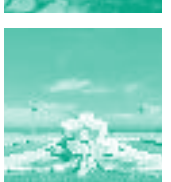
## **Dannunziana Pine Forest (Pineta Dannunziana)**

A nature reserve within the city, great for a peaceful walk surrounded by maritime pines and native flora.



## **Seafront Promenade & “La Nave” by Pietro Cascella**

The coastal promenade features “The Ship,” a monumental sculpture and symbol of Pescara.





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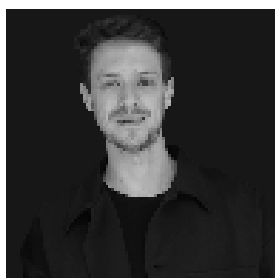
